How Much Does It Cost To Study In Canada From Nepal?

The Cost Of Studying In Canada From Nepal Varies Depending On A Number Of Factors, Including The Level Of Study, The Institution Chosen, And The Province Of Residence. However, As A General Guide, International Students Can Expect To Pay Between CAD 15,000 And CAD 35,000 Per Year For Tuition Fees. Living Expenses, Including Accommodation, Food, Transportation, And

What Are The Different Types Of Student Visas For Canada?

- **Study Permit:** This Visa Allows You To Study In Canada For A Period Of Up To Six Months.
- **Student Visa:** This Visa Allows You To Study In Canada For A Period Of Longer Than Six Months.
